

NOTICE OF PROJECT COMMENCEMENT

Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA) is preparing to undertake bank restoration work along a section of East Don River within East Don Parkland. The site is located south of Finch Avenue East and west of Leslie Street. The purpose of this project is to protect a section of formal path within East Don Parklands below Alamosa Drive.



Construction is scheduled to commence the week of February 27, 2012 upon the receipt of the necessary approvals, taking approximately four (4) weeks to complete. Final site restoration (e.g. tree planting, asphalt repairs, etc.), will be completed following construction, as weather conditions permit.

During construction, equipment will access the work area via the formal path that connects to Finch Avenue East, just west of Alamosa Drive. In the interest of protecting public safety, the trail connection between Finch Avenue and the main entrance off of Alamosa Drive will be closed. TRCA requests that the public exercise caution and stay clear of the site while the work is underway.
