

Birds of West Deane Park

A group of 80 people gathered at West Deane Park to participate in this event and learn about the various bird species using this green space. This park is home to several native birds and serves as a migratory path for many other avian species. Participants had the opportunity to browse conservation displays, experience a live falcon demonstration hosted by Falcon Environmental, construct bird feeders and song bird nesting structures, explore the park through an interpretive hike and learn how to identify birds by both sight and sound.
