## Wildwood Park, Fall Community Planting

Wildwood Park has recently been impacted by the threat of the invasive Long-horned Asian Beetle resulting in the controlled removal of many trees and shrubs. Members of the Malton Community Building Project attended the park to assist with the task of restoring this area and planted 200 native trees and shrubs. Vegetation along the watercourse acts as a filter during storm events and reduces harmful pollutants entering the system. These trees and shrubs also provide necessary habitat for wildlife in the area. Stewardship activities like this provide educational awareness of the importance of green space in urban settings.
