2015 EM Accomplishments



Pratt & Whitney employees held their annual Enviro Day event with highly successful results. They planted 300 native trees and shrubs to enhance the valley land at Edward Scarlett Park and also participated in the Young Tree Monitoring program to collect data on general health of the new and recent plantings in the valley. These new plantings will help provide habitat for wildlife and buffer contaminants carried by storm water runoff to Etobicoke Creek. During the event, employees worked closely with TRCA staff to conduct maintenance work on the meadow plots located on the property and installed 3 “Bee Condo’s” and 2 bird structures. Pratt and Whitney employees also conducted a clean-up within the surrounding natural areas as part of the event and collected approximately 280 lbs of trash and litter. These Stewardship activities allowed the group a better understanding of natural spaces and provided an understanding of the importance of a healthy diverse ecosystem.
