



FLOOD WARNING CANCELLATION/ FLOOD ADVISORY UPDATE

Toronto and Region Conservation advises that water levels in the Don River are receding and as such, the Flood Warning issued on July 25, 2009 at 7:50 pm has been cancelled.

Rivers and streams continue to run at high levels and should be considered dangerous. Please be advised that the Weather Office is predicting additional showers and thunderstorms throughout the day on Sunday. These rainfall amounts may again result in flooding of low-lying areas, and also create street flooding and sewer surcharging. Due to the potential for flooding, a Flood Advisory remains in effect.

The TRCA will continue to closely monitor the weather conditions and will issue an update or cancellation to the Flood Advisory by 10:00 pm on Sunday, July 26, 2009. The High Water Safety Bulletin will remain in effect until Monday July 27, 2009. Please visit our website at www.trca.on.ca to see the current Flood Advisory message.
