



HIGH WATER SAFETY BULLETIN AND CANCELLATION OF FLOOD ADVISORY

Toronto and Region Conservation advises that water levels, in rivers and streams of our jurisdiction, are receding following the recent rainfall. Further threats of flooding in rivers and streams of our jurisdiction are no longer anticipated at the moment. The Flood Advisory issued on Sunday 26 July, 2009 at 10:00PM is now cancelled.

However, the ponds, rivers and streams, within our jurisdiction, will remain at above normal water levels and flow rates for the next few days. These water bodies should be considered dangerous. Please exercise caution around all water bodies and alert any children under your care of these dangers. This High Water Safety Bulletin will be in effect through Wednesday July 29, 2009.
